### SELECTION CRITERIA

National teams are selected using a set of criteria which are considered by WGSA to be important in determining those individuals who will have the honour to represent South Africa.

The criteria used are as follows:

- ~ the performance of players in tournaments with ranking points
- ~ stroke averages in tournaments / diff to calculated rating\*\*\*\*
- ~ performance in events not included - eg International events
- ~ past performance in representative teams
- ~ ability to add value to a team
- ~ attitude and behaviour

In this regard, attitude and behaviour is regarded as one of the most important of all the criteria. Players who are eligible for selection – irrespective of their position on the ranking list - will be those who consistently display a respect for the etiquette of the game, as well as an attitude and behaviour that is of the highest standard. The reasons for this are simple. Once selected, these players will become role models for many other aspiring golfers. In addition, they will be representing South Africa and all that it stands for and finally, because attitude and behaviour is fundamental to the performance of both the individual and the team.

\*\*\*\* We will use the top 33% of the nett scores to obtain the standard par of the round and this will be the Calculated Rating. The handicap differential for stroke averages will be the difference between a player's gross score and the Calculated Rating of each round.
